A man and a woman sit at their respective windows across from each other on a busy street in Berlin, Germany, and observe the interesting minor dramas unfolding on the street below them. They never speak, but they acknowledge each other's presence. But then one day, the man does not appear. What should the woman do?

Instead of relying on a preponderance of dialogue to express emotion and move the story forward, the scriptwriter, Tara Lynn Orr, and director, Benjamin Wolff, expertly use the characters' actions to tenderly reveal the story to the viewer, the courage it takes for the woman to act and the bittersweet result. This 19-minute smile awaits you at the Breckenridge Backstage Theatre on Saturday, Sept. 20. It will screen with a block of three films starting at 6 p.m., including "Things I Have Learned About Sex and Dogs" and "That Thing with the Cat."
